## **Allegany SCD Rental Equipment**

It is the responsibility of the person or persons who rent equipment to provide for over the road transportation of the machine in a safe manner. All equipment uses a pin hitch to transport. THE PERSON OR PERSONS WHO RENT, TRANSPORT OR OPERATE THE EQUIPMENT ASSUME ALL LIABILITY AND RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY ACCIDENTS INVOLVING THE TRANSPORT OR USE OF THE MACHINE.

Please call the office at 240-609-3493 immediately if the equipment is not working or is in need of repair. Leave a message if your call is after hours. If you do not report the need for repair or continue to use the equipment when it is not functioning properly, you will be charged for the repair cost. Any damage beyond normal wear will be the responsibility of the renter.

**Great Plains No-Till Drill**: The drill is available for rent at a fee of \$7.00 per acre with a minimum \$50 charge for the first day plus \$30/day for each consecutive day if not returned by 12:00 noon. Before moving the drill there is a policy and procedure page that must be read, signed and dated. You will be given a checklist to record starting and ending acreage as well as procedures to



operate. This checklist must be completed and returned when you bring the drill back for proper billing. The Great Plains Drill is a heavy piece of equipment that weighs approximately 1.5 tons. Movement of the drill <u>requires</u> a medium size tractor of 55-65 horsepower or a heavy duty truck equipped with a heavy duty hitch securely fastened to the frame of the vehicle. Bumper hitches and/or small trucks are unsafe and <u>shall not be used</u> to transport the drill as well as undersized tractors. An adequate size vehicle equipped with a proper hitch as described MUST be used to transport the drill.



Wheatheart High & Heavy Hitter Post Pounder: Can ONLY use pressure treated posts or native posts. User MUST complete the rental form and demo PRIOR to moving the equipment. <u>RATES</u>: \$100/day for the first day plus \$50/day for each consecutive day if not returned by 12:00 noon (cannot exceed more than 5 consecutive days). Depending on project location, a pre-visit by an ASCD staff member may be scheduled. The post pounder weighs approximately 2,580 lbs. <u>Movement requires a truck equipped with a hitch that has adequate towing capacity</u>. It cannot be transported at speeds that exceed 55 mph. Two or more people <u>must</u> be present while operating the equipment. The post pounder MUST NOT be operated on slopes greater than 15%.

Failure to comply with any of the fore mentioned conditions will result in your suspension to use district equipment.
